



Photograph Frames

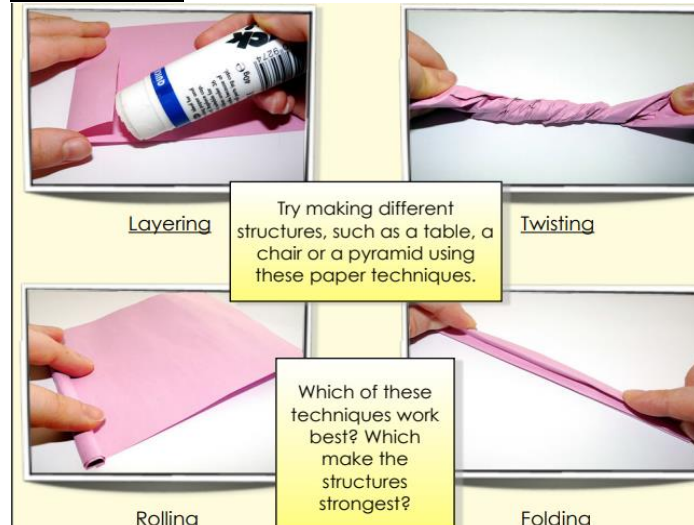

We will challenge ourselves to make the frames free-standing.

- What will you do if something in your plan goes wrong?
